If you are in the process of becoming a licensed and registered FCC or FFN, it is required that you and your sub/alternate/assistant pay the \$60 at the time of the training. Should you complete the application process within 3 months of completing the CPR training, the money will be returned to you. If you fail to complete the application process, 3 months from the date of the training the money is forfeited and you will not receive the reimbursement.
