Dear Friends.

When we reflect on the 2021-2022 year, we celebrate hope, as it gave us the resilience to deal with the lingering impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Challenges related to loss, social isolation, stress, and depression have been especially difficult for families in low-income communities, where resources and support are often limited. While many organizations were forced to end services due to decreased funding, reduced staffing or high staff turnover, The Children's Home Society of New Jersey (CHSofNJ) was able to adapt and evolve in these unprecedented, challenging times to help even more babies, children, youth, and families find the strength to not only carry on, but to thrive despite the unexpected obstacles laid in front of them.

During the 2021-2022 fiscal year, we are proud to have expanded our Maternal Child Health services to further support our work to improve birth outcomes in New Jersey. We achieved this by enhancing our AMAR Community Doula program through the training of a new cohort of certified doulas, extending doula care to more diverse families, and helping to seed the Community of Caring - Paterson Doula Cooperative. Additionally, we are proud to have incorporated the ability to accept Medicaid payment for services, thereby enabling us to help more children and families.

How did we manage to grow during these trying times? We leaned on our longstanding partnerships to strengthen and update our infrastructure. We built new community service collaborations to better meet the needs of our children and families. We ensured the necessary professional development for our staff to approach all service delivery and interactions with families, partners, and colleagues through a traumainformed lens. And we enhanced our focus on Corporate Social Responsibility and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion to ensure an environment where everyone would feel welcome, safe, heard, and respected.

Our accomplishments this past year, and every year since 1894, are the result of visionary leadership from our Board and Management team: hard work from our talented and well-trained staff; input and active participation from the families we serve: and generous support from individual donors and our corporate. foundation and government partners. We truly are a team in this important work, and if the pandemic has proven anything, it is that we could not ask for a better CHSofNJ team. Thank you for all that you have done and continue to do for the babies, children, youth, and families we serve!

Our inclusive programs for children and families support child welfare (including abuse and neglect prevention and treatment, adoption, kinship support, and more); early childhood and parent education; clinical and behavioral health services; school-based youth development; and maternal-child health programming and support from pregnancy through labor/delivery and postnatal care. We proudly sponsor federal WIC, 21st Century Community Learning Centers, and Head Start/Early Head Start programs in Trenton. In all that we do, we strive to operate through a trauma-informed lens and be guided by our Diversity, Equity and Inclusion values.

What makes us unique? CHSofNJ's culture since 1894 is to listen to the children and families we serve. We help families decide what they want to achieve, and we support them in attaining the goals they set for themselves. We provide access to skills, knowledge, and resources to empower families and inform life choices. We evaluate our outcomes and adapt our programming and services as needed to best meet the ever-evolving needs of the community we serve.

In Fiscal Year 2021-22, nearly 300 highly-trained staff members, 21 dedicated Board members and 13 Honorary Board members, 24 passionate Auxiliary Board members and 12 Associate Auxiliary members, and 900 caring volunteers went the extra mile every day to provide statewide services from 11 locations in support of CHSofNJ's mission: saving children's lives and building healthy families. Statement of Operating Revenues and Expenditures Financial Overview - Fiscal Year Ended May 31, 2022

The operating budget of CHSofNJ relies on funding from federal, state, and county government grants and private contributions, with a major portion of the budget coming from a collaborative partnership with several New Jersey state agencies. Although the funds we receive from these government grants are our mainstay, private dollars acquired through additional fundraising efforts are necessary to supplement grants in order to provide the level of quality and the intensity of services that are critical to achieve successful outcomes that save children's lives and build healthy families.




